Detail of Rules and Regulations

Original research papers along with bio-data of the authors who are Masters in Geography and have not attained the age of 32 years are invited from all over India and SAARC countries for the Young Geographer Award competition. A soft copy of the paper prepared according to the format of 'Punjab Geographer' should be submitted in English to Dr. B.R. Thakur, who has been authorized by the APG Secretariat to coordinate this competition. The name of the author and department should not be mentioned on the paper to keep the secrecy. Evaluation will take place only if there are at least six participants. The paper must accompany a proof for the age and a certificate about the originality of the paper (Annexture-1).

The three best papers will be short-listed through the approved procedure for presentation in a special session of the conference and one among them would be finally selected for **Dr. Saminderjit Singh Young Geographer Award.** The awardee will be honoured with a cash prize of Rs. 5000/- and a certificate of merit. The paper can be published in the Journal if considered fit for publication by the editorial team.
